## chardonnay

**Chime, North Coast, Ca (2018)**

5.75 (6 oz.) / 8.65 (9 oz.) / 23 (bottle)

vibrantly aromatic and light golden in color, this wine exemplifies the multi-faceted style of cool climate chardonnay

**Butter, Jam Cellars, Ca (2018)**

7.75 (6 oz.) / 11.65 (9 oz.) / 31 (bottle)

rich, bold and delicious. butter brims with stone fruit and baked lemon notes with a long lasting vanilla finish

**Kendall Jackson Vintners Reserve, Ca (2017)**

6.5 (6 oz.) / 9.75 (9 oz.) / 26 (bottle)

pineapple, mango, and papaya with citrus notes that explode in your mouth delicately intertwined with aromas of vanilla and honey to create depth and balance throughout

**Rombauer Vineyards Carneros, Ca (2018)**

23 (6 oz.) / 34.5 (9 oz.) / 92 (bottle)

aromas of bright citrus and melon are layered with spice, vanilla and a touch of butter. vibrant mango and guava meld with vanilla and soft spice on the creamy, rich palate with refreshing acidity



## sparkling

**Chateau Napoleon, Ca**

sparkling wine appropriate for any occasion

**Perrier-Jouet Gran Brut**

85 (bottle)

a perfect introduction to the floral, stylish and diamond-cut style of the perrier-jouet house

**LaMarca, Prosecco, Italy NV**

7 (6 oz.) / 10.5 (9 oz.) / 28 (bottle)

fresh citrus, honey and white flowers; fresh and clean, with flavors of ripe lemon, green apple and grapefruit framed by mineral undertones

## other whites

**Hanna, Sauvignon Blanc, Russian River, Ca (2018)**

10 (6 oz.) / 15 (9 oz.) / 40 (bottle)

aromas of bright citrus mingle with gooseberry and passion fruit, leaving the palate full of juicy citrus flavors of lime, grapefruit and tangerine

**Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, Nz (2019)**

8 (6 oz.) / 12 (9 oz.) / 32 (bottle)

citrus and tropical fruits backed by characteristic herbaceous notes for which marlborough sauvignon blanc is renowned

**Villa M, Moscato d'Asti Gagliardo, Piedmont, Ita (2017)**

8.5 (6 oz.) / 12.75 (9 oz.) / 34 (bottle)

delightfully small bubbles, pear, melon, passion fruit and crisp apple tones

**Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio, Ita (2019)**

13 (6 oz.) / 19.5 (9 oz.) / 52 (bottle)

clean, intense aroma and bone-dry taste with an appealing flavor of golden delicious apples make it a wine of great personality and versatility

**Frisk Prickly Riesling, Au (2018)**

5.5 (6 oz.) / 8.25 (9 oz.) / 22 (bottle)

not for the faint of heart, this zippy riesling is floral with notes of lime sorbet, rose petals and a hint of fennel and subtle complexity and just a tinge of sweetness

**Fleur de Prairie, VinDeProvence Rose (2018)**

5.5 (6 oz.) / 8.25 (9 oz.) / 33 (bottle)

the wine is sourced from select provençal vineyards that dot the coastal wind-swept hillsides of the region. the mediterranean combination of sun, wind, mild water stress, and ocean influence provide ideal conditions for grapes to ripen to the perfect balance of flavor and freshness

**The Palm, Whispering Angel, VinDeProvence Rose (2018)**

8.25 (6 oz.) / 12.40 (9 oz.) / 33 (bottle)

the palm is a blend of grenache, cinsault and syrah made from grapes which are selected from the best vineyards in the appellation côteaux d'aix-en-provence

# Reds



## *cabernet*

**Hess Shirtail Ranches Lake County, Ca (2017)**

10 (6 oz.) / 15 (9 oz.) / 40 (bottle)

bright with aromas and flavors of red fruits led by raspberry and cherry; darker fruits noticeable black cherry and spicy notes of currants, anise, cloves and cedar, highlighted with a touch of vanilla

**Joseph Carr, Paso Robles, Ca (2014)**

47 (bottle)

distinctive aromas of cherry and blackberry fruit are followed by subtle notes of oak and vanilla

**Josh Cellars, Ca (2017)**

7.5 (6 oz.) / 11.25 (9 oz.) / 30 (bottle)

layers of cassis, blackberry coffee and vanilla. rich, intense and complex

**Concanon, Paso Robles, Ca (2017)**

8 (6 oz.) / 12 (9 oz.) / 32 (bottle)

rich aromas and luscious flavors of intense red cherry, ripe plum and black currant intermingling with hints of cocoa, vanilla and spice



## *merlot*

**Noble Vines Collection 181, Ca (2017)**

29 (bottle)

classic bordeaux-style merlot, initial aromas of cherry, blackberry and sweet herbs. black cherry and ripe plum fuse seamlessly with hints of spice leading to a lingering and luxurious finish

**Kenwood, Sonoma County, Ca (2016)**

7 (6 oz.) / 10.5 (9 oz.) / 28 (bottle)

good color and excellent texture. the remainder of the blend is balanced with the rich fruit and spicy flavors from grapes sourced in the dry creek and alexander valleys

**Concannon Petite Sirah, Livermore, Ca (2017)**

27 (bottle)

enjoy this artful expression of voluptuous blackberry, blueberry and layered spice leading to a long, velvety finish

## *pinot noir*

**Meiomi, Ca (2017)**

10 (6 oz.) / 15 (9 oz.) / 40 (bottle)

medium weight, rich with subtle edges of blueberry and mocha, ending with a black licorice finish

**Siduri, Willamette Valley, Or (2016)**

48 (bottle)

the chelhalem mountain fruit, along with the richer and rounder wines from the yamhill-carlton and eola-amity areas, gives it a broad range of flavors, to create a wine that is simultaneously rich and zippy



## *other reds*

**Ménage à Trois Winery Red Blend, Ca (2018)**

6 (6 oz.) / 9 (9 oz.) / 24 (bottle)

this red blend brings together three strange bedfellows: zinfandel, merlot and cabernet sauvignon

**The Prisoner, Napa Valley, Ca (2018)**

20 (6 oz.) / 30 (9 oz.) / 80 (bottle)

features enticing aromas of bing cherry, dark chocolate, clove and roasted fig, persistent flavors of ripe raspberry, boysenberry, pomegranate, and vanilla, linger harmoniously, for a smooth and luscious finish

**Piatelli Malbec, Arg (2017)**

8 (6 oz.) / 12 (9 oz.) / 32 (bottle)

purple in color with aromatic notes of ripe plum and violet, reserve malbec's fruity bouquet delights the senses; the mouth is marked by structure and softness. full-bodied and bright, this is a very food-friendly wine

**Graffigna Centenario Malbec, Arg (2018)**

6.5 (6 oz.) / 9.75 (9 oz.) / 26 (bottle)

initial aromas of blackberries and red stone fruits, backed by mocha, spices and jams. the palate is soft and structured and perfectly rounded with a long lingering after taste

**Saldo, Zinfandel, Ca (2018)**

49 (bottle)

dark ruby color with bold aromas of black licorice, black pepper, cherry, and baking spice. the entry is rich, full, and scintillating; the palate is mouthwatering and smooth with a hint of chocolate; the finish is voluptuous with soft, velvety tannins
